WHEREAS, the City of Colton has determined the need to set the following fines and fees:

Sanitation Service License	\$ 200.00 annually
Transient Merchant, Auctioneers, Peddler, Solicitors License	\$ 10.00 each event
Circus	\$ 50.00 per day
Menageries	\$ 50.00 per day
Sideshow	\$ 25.00 per day
Carnival	\$ 50.00 per day
Swimming Pool Daily Pass	\$ 1.00 per session
Swimming Pool Season Pass	\$ 30.00 single pass \$ 50.00 family pass
Swimming Pool Party	\$ 50.00 (2 lifeguards required)
Rubble Site Maintenance Fee	\$ 1.00 per utility bill per month

FINES

Animal Running At Large	\$ 50.00 for first offense each animal \$ 100.00 for each additional offense for each animal
Animal Disturbing The Peace	\$ 50.00 each offense

Failure to License An Animal	\$ 25.00 each animal
Curfew Violation	\$ 75.00 each offense
Solid Waste Disposal Site Violation	\$ 200.00 each offense
Parking Ban	\$ 25.00
Abandoned, Wrecked or Dismantled Vehicle	\$ 25.00 per day
Burning Ban	\$ 50.00 first offense \$ 100.00 each additional offense
Return Check Penalty	\$ 30.00 per item returned

BE IT RESOLVED the City of Colton hereby authorizes these fees and fines to take effect January 1, 2010 and hereby designates these charges to be enforced and collected by the appropriate agency.

The foregoing resolution was introduced by LeRoy Koopman who moved for its passage and adoption; council member Matthew Swartwout seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with Karen Burgers, LeRoy Koopman, Jeffrey Pedersen, Matthew Swartwout and Ryan Tellberg voting aye.

Whereupon Council President Jeffrey Pedersen declared the resolution passed and adopted and instructed the Municipal Finance Officer to publish this resolution in the official newspaper of the city and to comply otherwise with all applicable notice requirements of the law.
